

Electric Cars for Everyone

Good for the environment: Significantly reduced greenhouse gases and air pollution when driving electric; three times more efficient than a combustion engine.

Convenient: Charge at home, at work or at 10,000+ public chargers.



Budget friendly: Low lease rates; up to \$7,500 federal tax credit, \$2,500 California rebate, and local rebates.* Less than \$1 to drive 25 miles.

Practical: Range is greater than most Californian's daily drive. And you drive alone in the carpool lane with an eligible electric car.

Family cars: More than 15 models have seating for five passengers. All electric cars meet federal safety standards.

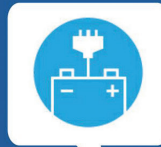
Apartment accessible: California law allows for installation of charging equipment at resident's cost.

All Electric

100% electric

15-50 electric miles
~300 gasoline miles

Charging

Level 1 Charge



4-6 miles range
per hour of charge



Level 1: 110-volt plug attached to a standard connector

Level 2 Charge



10-24 miles range
per hour of charge



Level 2: Special equipment attached to a standard connector



DC Fast Charge

80% of max range
under 30 minutes of charge



DCFC: Publicly available equipment with special connectors that some electric cars can use
